

McKinley Middle Magnet 2017-2018 Uniform Policy

Khaki bottoms:

- Slacks, shorts, skirts and jumpers (not more than 5 inches above the knee), and capris slacks; Khaki bottoms must be made of khaki fabric. (British and mushroom khaki are not acceptable.) Khaki colored jeans, corduroy, biking shorts, cargo pants/shorts, and sweat pants are unacceptable.
- Excessively tight fitting/stretch pants are not acceptable.
- Pants shall be worn at natural waist and shall not be excessively baggy.
- Pants with elastic cuffs/hems are not permitted!

Tops:

- Plain navy blue shirts/blouses with a collar; navy blue turtlenecks are acceptable in the winter. (Only our approved school logo is permitted on uniform tops!)
- Navy blue T-shirts are unacceptable.
- ONLY short sleeved white T-shirts may be worn under uniform shirts.

Jackets:

- Only Solid navy blue light weight jackets (hoodies) and sweaters are permitted! (Do not bring other colored jackets/sweaters on campus!)
- ONLY MCKINLEY MIDDLE SWEATSHIRTS MAY BE WORN! (Purchased through the school)
- Note: The only color jacket that can be brought to school is navy blue. The only color sweatshirt is burgundy.

Coats:

- We suggest a *dark colored heavy jacket or coat (navy, white, brown, gray or black)* to be worn in the winter but must be removed inside the building. Coats should be placed in the student's locker.

Belts:

- Belts (any color) must be worn at the natural waist on bottoms with belt loops; shirts/blouses and T-shirts must be tucked in.

Socks:

- Any color is acceptable. No prints of drugs, weapons, or alcohol paraphernalia.

Jewelry:

- Girls may wear stud earrings in their ears only. Boys are not permitted to wear earrings. No excessively large jewelry will be permitted.

Footwear:

- Closed-toe footwear with soles and a back must be worn in school facilities and on school grounds (sneakers are permissible).

***Approved school spirit shirts, sports sweatshirts, club and team apparel may be worn on Fridays ONLY.
Bandannas and blankets are unacceptable at McKinley Middle School.***

Free Dress/Awards Day Dress Policy

- No hats or head apparel such as bandanas, and do rags may not be worn.
- T-shirts or other articles that display any type of violence, profane, or obscene languages are unacceptable.
- Pants must be worn at the natural waist and shall not be excessively baggy nor sagging.
- Closed toe shoes/sneakers with backs must be worn. (No sandals)
- Shorts and skirts may not be more than 5 inches above the knee.
- Absolutely, no skin should be shown through pants/jeans.
- No jeggings/leggings may be worn as pants.
- No low cut or excessively tight clothing may be worn.
- If wearing tank tops/camisoles, they must be layered with a shirt/blouse on top of the camisole/tank top. (Shoulders/undergarments may not be exposed.)
- Large earrings may not be worn.
